The Blessed Marie Anne Blondin Bursary Fund was established by the Sisters of Saint Ann, St. Joseph Province to provide educational funding for **lay women** of the Nelson Diocese. Awarded funds are disbursed to the Educational Institution.

The **criteria** for application are:

- 1) Applicants must be active and involved parishioners of a Catholic Church within the Roman Catholic Diocese of Nelson.
- 2) Applicants must be accepted into a program or course of study for ministry in the Catholic Church (i.e., religious education, liturgy, social justice, social action, care of the sick, etc.), or demonstrate a need for financial assistance in order to enroll in a program which will enable her and her family to become self-sufficient and healthy.
