My name is Gerry Fee and I serve as your Parish Council Chairman.

The church, in this authority, has given us five Precepts. These precepts are "obligatory", not optional, if we want to call ourselves Catholic; and they are intended to be "positive", to guarantee the very minimum of what we need to do to be called Catholic.

What are the five precepts of the Catholic Church?

"You shall attend mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labour;" "You shall confess your sins at least once a year;" "You shall receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season;" "You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church;" "You shall help provide for the needs of the Church."

That last precept means that we are obliged, as Catholics, to provide for the material needs of the church, according to our ability. I would like to focus on that last precept for a few minutes.

Our parish employee expenses cover our pastor; an office administrator/bookkeeper; a maintenance/ caretaker; and two half-time employees. You probably can imagine the work of office administrator and caretaker but what do the part time employees do for us. These half-time employees organize Mass readers, Ushers, Live streamers, coordinate religious education, Youth Ministry, RCIA, and adult faith formation.

Mathew Kelly, who is an Australian author and motivational speaker, found that in a Catholic parish, 90% of the church is funded by 6-7% of the parish. 90% of what happens in any given parish is funded by 6-7% of that parish. So, the remaining 10% is funded by 93-94% of the Parish.

In this week's bulletin, the Finance Committee has included a cash flow statement for ICC parish to the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. You will see that, unless we see a windfall of giving before the end of December, we will be short about \$50,000 to pay our expenses and Pilgrimage of Faith appeal. So about \$1,000 per week. We have 250-300 families that give regularly to our weekly collection. So, we are short about \$3-\$4 per giving family. I know the cost of living has stretched most of us to the brink. I know some of us give what we feel is the maximum we can afford. On the other hand, I don't see where we can reduce expenses and still fulfill our mission to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ.

So, as individuals, we can't do it all, but I hope collectively we can all do something. My suggestion for you to consider, is to increase our weekly giving by 10%. If we give \$5 per week, can we give \$5.50? If we give \$10 per week, can we give \$11? If we give \$100 per week, can we give \$110?

As Father Mike Schmidt often says, "we belong to one another." Christianity is not a spectator sport but rather needs the participation of everyone. Thank you for your consideration and attention.



### BIODATA OF FR. DR. SHAIJU (JOHN), CMI

FR DR SHAIJU, a Religious Missionary Priest in the Congregation of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate, hails from the Diocese of Irinjalakkuda, Kerala, India. His Baptismal name is John and his name in the Congregation is Vineeth John. He is the only son of his Late parents. He has 4 elder sisters as siblings.

After the completion of his Secondary Education, Fr Shaiju joined the CMI Congregation in May 1990. He took the First Religious Vows on March 19, 1997. He was ordained Priest on December 29, 2003. He celebrates his Birthday on March 17 and his Feast Day on December 14 (Feast of St John of the Cross).

After ordination Fr Shaiju was appointed as Assistant Rector to the Seminarians (2004 - 2007). He worked in an ICSE School as Principal (2007–2013), and in an Arts and Science College as Vice Principal and General Co-ordinator of the Programmes (2014–2024). Fr Shaiju has a PhD in Educational Psychology. He has 3 years' teaching experience in the seminary, 6 years' teaching experience in the school and 10 years' teaching experience in the college.


